


BALTIMORE SHAKESPEARE FACTORY PRESENTS: OTHELLO

Q12 SURVEYS AND RESULTS



During November 2017, the Employee Engagement Committee surveyed the staff, division by division, to better understand staff engagement. We received 217 surveys! Over 62% of the Department responded which is a 10% increase from the last survey in March 2017. While each division has unique differences, here are some consistencies across all divisions:

- 1.Staff is confident in what is expected of them at work.
- 2.Most feel that their supervisor, or someone at work, cares about them.
- 3.In the last seven days, many employees have not received recognition or praise for doing good work.
- 4. Frontline and non-supervisory staff believe that their opinions do not matter.
- 5. Many staff members don't feel as if they have a best friend at work.

The Engagement Committee will meet with leadership and staff to discuss these findings over the next month and make recommendations to improve employee moral and interactions. Thank you to everyone who participated in the survey!
